Transport

<u>Ring and Ride service</u> – Tel. **01884 242099** for information or booking. Tail lift minibuses provide accessible transport to town centres for disabled and frail elderly persons (escorts welcome). There are routine weekly trips to Tiverton on Tuesdays and Exeter on 1st and 3rd Thursdays and shop mobility.

Voluntary car service 50-90p per mile. (needs booking in advance)

Link-up service

This service is a voluntary group providing transport for both Wyndham House and Exe Valley Surgeries. It is designed to take elderly or disabled patients, who have no alternative means of travel, to the surgery or to hospital in Exeter or Tiverton. There is no fee for this service but donations to **Link- Up** may be given to the drivers to help cover the costs. There is a list of drivers available at each of the surgeries.
