

A Guide to Booking Flu Clinic Appointments online

- 1. If you haven't done so already collect your username and password from the surgery you will need some form of photo ID, but you can also collect usernames and passwords for other people who you normally order repeat prescriptions for online (ie. children under your care or other people you care for). Your username will be your name followed by your date of birth as 6 numbers and your password will be eight characters with at least one number and symbol.
- 2. The can take a while to update, but try 2 hours later to logon to www.wyndhamhousesurgery.co.uk and follow the link to SystmOnline either through the Front Page Flu picture or via the Book Appointments link. You will get to this screen:




3. **Login here** using the details given to you – being careful to type the password and username correctly, and ensuring that the Caps Lock button is not on.

If you log on too early or get something wrong it will look like this:



If you've done it right this screen will open up:




If this is the first time you have logged into SystmOnline you should **change your password**. This must be 8 characters or more, and contain at least one number and one symbol (eg. %, *, !, ?).

- 4. To book an appointment at the flu clinic go to the tab at the top marked Book Appointment.
- 5. This screen will appear:




Scroll down to the day of the flu clinic and some appointments will show marked as Wyndham Flu Clinic 1,2 & 3.



Click on View to see the appointments in more detail.

6. You will see this screen:




Click on Book to book your preferred appointment time,
