Transport

Ring and Ride service

Tel. **01884 242099** for information or booking. Tail lift minibuses provide accessible transport to town centres for disabled and frail elderly persons (escorts welcome).

There are routine weekly trips to Tiverton on Tuesdays or Wednesday mornings.

Exeter Saturday Club.

Voluntary car service 55p per mile.

All transport needs booking in advance and will collect and deliver you to your home.

Link-Up service

This service is a voluntary group providing transport for Wyndham House Surgery. It is designed to take elderly or disabled patients, who have no alternative means of travel, to the surgery or to hospital in Exeter or Tiverton. There is no fee for this service but donations to Link Up may be given to the drivers to help cover the costs which are underwritten by The Friends Of Wyndham House Surgery. There is a list of drivers available at the surgery and on the website.

New volunteer drivers are needed for Link up and Ring and Ride

Home Visit Health Assessment

This is a service sponsored by The Friends of Wyndham House Surgery for elderly people. The aim of the visit is to help to keep you safe and healthy in your own home. It provides a visit from Sue Clarke a friendly, qualified and experienced nurse, who will check any health concerns you may have and advise you on any equipment or support to enable you to remain safe in your home. Sue will also discuss and review your medication. She may need to take a blood test and will ask you questions about any recent falls, and about your eyesight and hearing, appetite and cooking arrangements. She will also ask about family and social support and can make referrals to meet your health needs. If you would like her to visit you please contact the surgery.

Prescription Delivery

Wyndham House Surgery has a free prescription delivery service which we call "Bertie". This is for people who have health difficulties and are therefore unable to get to the surgery. It is run by a team of volunteer drivers who will deliver repeat prescriptions. The service is sponsored by the Friends of Wyndham House Surgery.

If you are unable to collect your prescription and would like to use the "Bertie" service, please contact the surgery.

Balance Classes

Thanks to support from the **Friends of Wyndham House** we are now running courses of Balance Classes for people who have had falls, or are at risk of falling. These classes help to improve your strength and reduce the risk of falling.
